Short Term Examples: Run for a class office, improve my English grades, update my portfolio.

Long Term Example: Complete a College Degree, Travel to Europe.

- Next click on Career Planning Activities
- Select an activity from drop down (job shadowing, record the details Title/Organization, Start and End Dates, and Description of specific activity.)
- Next click Post Secondary Plan
- Continue building and exploring your Career and Educational Goals and Financial Plans
